

"BASYANG" MAINTAINS ITS WEST SOUTHWEST DIRECTION AS IT TRAVERSES SULU SEA

- Scattered to widespread moderate to heavy rains will prevail in the next 24 hours over Palawan and Western Visayas. Meanwhile, scattered light to moderate with at times heavy rains is expected over the rest of Visayas, rest of MIMAROPA, Bicol Region, Zamboanga Peninsula, and Caraga. Residents of these areas must continue monitoring for updates, take appropriate measures against possible flooding and landslides, and coordinate with their respective local disaster risk reduction and management offices.
- Sea travel remains risky over the seaboards of areas under Tropical Cyclone Warning Signals (TCWS), as well as the seaboards of Northern Luzon and Palawan, the eastern seaboards of Central Luzon and of Visayas and the eastern seaboard of Southern Luzon due to the Tropical Depression and the surge of the Northeast Monsoon.
- Possible landfall over Southern Palawan tonight.
- Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal (TCWS) elsewhere are now lifted.
